## FIRST READING

**Deuteronomy 6: 3-9**



Great are the works of the Lord, great is the Lord!



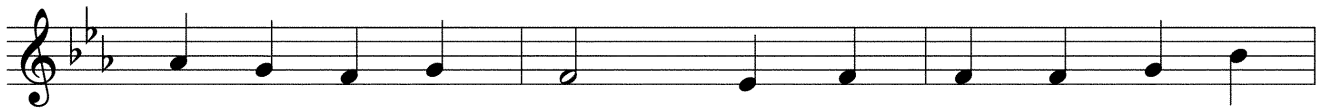
