



In all thy works I see thy glory, In mighty wonders; in small and simple things. My heart rejoices in the bounty set before me And my grateful spirit sings.


Each rising sun tells of thy goodness, The rain proclaims thee in the life it brings; All creation bears thee sure and silent witness And my grateful spirit sings.

And my grateful spirit sings.


