And my grateful spirit sings.


Each rising sun tells of thy goodness,

And my grateful spirit sings.



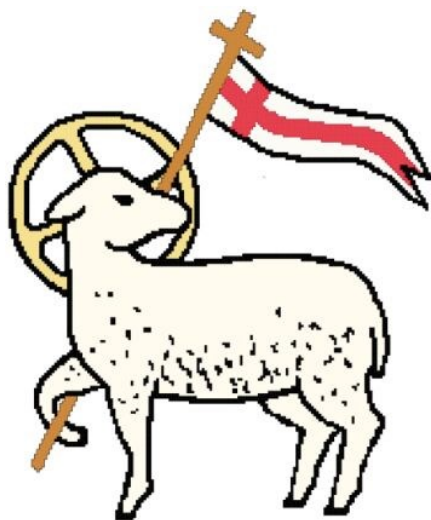
