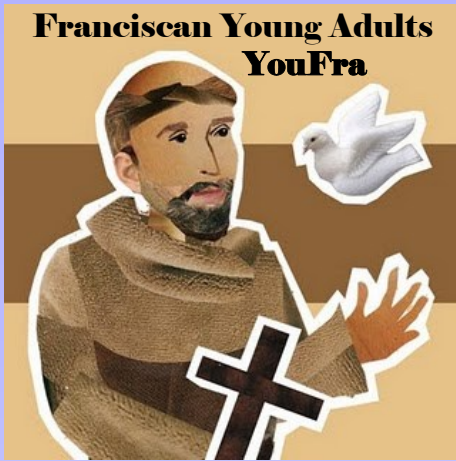

Healing our Image of God

God is love and the most perfect image of love is Jesus Christ.

Description:

Our attempts to describe God are limited by human nature. As human beings, we have a tendency to project our own image on the image of God. The nature of the Holy One is the greatest mystery, yet we by necessity perceive and speak of God in human terms, ideas, and languages.

During our workshops we'll reflect on the richness of images found in Scripture to describe God. We'll also examine our own past relationships and experiences to see if they have diminished our understanding of God as love.

Scripture provide us with two images of God that stand above all others in the Bible. The New Testament tells us that the most perfect description for God is love (1 Jn 4:8) and the most perfect image of love is Jesus. Jesus Christ is the "image of the invisible God" (Col 1:14). During our time together it is our hope you will experience the faithful love of God, who loves humanity without limits.

Learning Outcomes:

- Discover and explore the rich images of God found in Scripture. Experience the faithful love of God, who loves humanity without limits.
- Understand how the parables of Jesus reveal God's infinite, boundless, and extravagant mercy towards humanity.
- Develop a healthier understanding of sin, hell, and vengeance through the use of story, Scripture and theology.
