Dear Parents and Caregivers:

If we live the fruits of the Eucharist in our daily lives, we will fill our families and our communities with the life-giving qualities that the Mass brings: hospitality, concern for the poor and vulnerable, self-offering, and thanksgiving. - Jesus Gathers People Together.

- Our Community Shares a Meal.
- My First Eucharist Book.

These eight lessons will also be explored within your family setting. We recognize that what goes on in your home is the most important part of the preparation for Confirmation and First Eucharist. We also recognize that parents and caregivers are tremendously busy these days, so our goal is to assist you in making Confirmation and First Eucharist preparation an enjoyable part of your family activities. In addition, to exploring the above eight lessons you will also help your child learn their basic prayers.

As your child's first and most important religious educator, you have the right and the responsibility to be an active participant in their Confirmation and First Eucharist preparation. We will support you in that role and in the sharing of the gift of faith.
